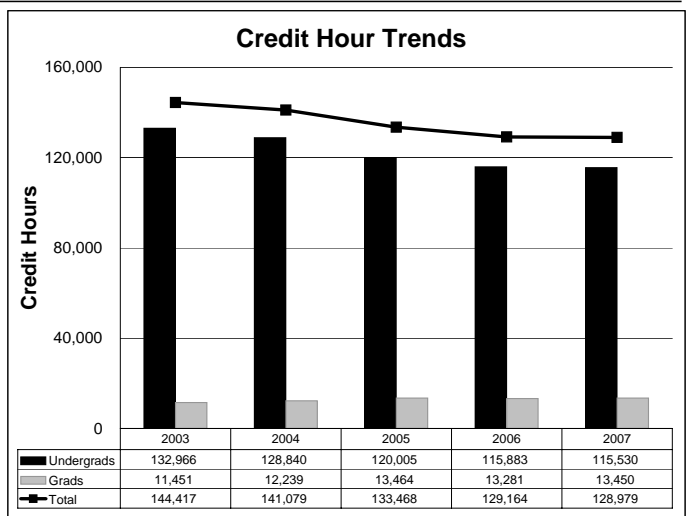
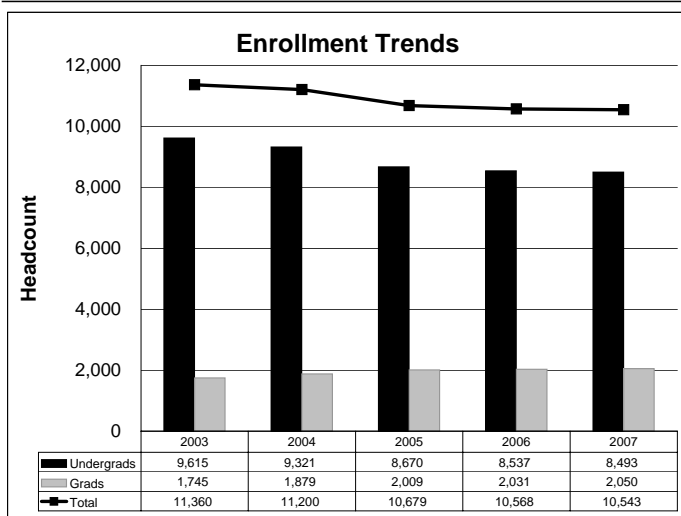

HIGHLIGHTS

ENROLLMENT CHANGES FROM FALL 2006 TO FALL 2007

► **UNIVERSITY TOTALS**

Total enrollment decreased by 25 students or 0.2%
 Total undergraduate enrollment decreased by 44 students or 0.5%.
 Total graduate student enrollment increased by 19 students or 0.9%.
 Total full-time equivalent (FTE)³ students decreased by 9.5 or 0.1%.

► **CLASSIFICATION⁴**

Freshman enrollment increased by 61 students or 2.0%.
 Sophomore enrollment decreased by 42 students or 2.6%.
 Junior enrollment decreased by 146 students or 8.4%.
 Senior enrollment increased by 83 students or 4.0%.

► **COLLEGE**

Enrollment increased in Health & Human Performance (34 students or 5.9%), Nursing (29 students or 4.5%), Student Academic Services (21 students or 2.4%), and in Graduate Studies (19 students or 0.9%). Enrollment decreased in Technology (54 students or 5.7%), Business (37 students or 3.1%), Arts & Sciences (23 students or 0.7%), Education (12 students or 1.8%), and in Non Degree (2 students or 1.0%).

► **U.S. MINORITY STUDENTS**

Total U.S. minority student enrollment increased by 61 students or 3.7%.
 Undergraduate U.S. minority enrollment increased by 48 students or 3.4%.
 Graduate U.S. minority enrollment increased by 13 students or 4.9%.

► **FULL-TIME STATUS⁵**

Full-time enrollment decreased by 17 students or 0.2%.
 Full-time undergraduates decreased by 33 students or 0.5%.
 Full-time graduate students increased by 16 students or 2.1%.

► **PART-TIME STATUS⁵**

Part-time enrollment decreased by 8 students or 0.3%.
 Part-time undergraduates decreased by 11 students or 0.9%.
 Part-time graduate students increased by 3 students or 0.2%.

► **IN-STATE RESIDENTS**

In-state students decreased by 195 students or 2.3%.
 In-state undergraduates decreased by 149 students or 2.0%.
 In-state graduate students decreased by 46 students or 4.3%.

► **OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS**

Out-of-state students increased by 192 students or 12.3%.
 Out-of-state undergraduates increased by 101 students or 11.1%.
 Out-of-state graduate students increased by 91 students or 13.9%.

► **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

International students decreased by 22 students or 4.9%.
 International undergraduates increased by 4 students or 2.9%.
 International graduate students decreased by 26 students or 8.4%.

¹ The international count shown on Page 1 (426) is different from the international count shown on Page 3 (110+267=377), because Page 1 is based on country of origin at admission and Page 3 is based on ethnicity.

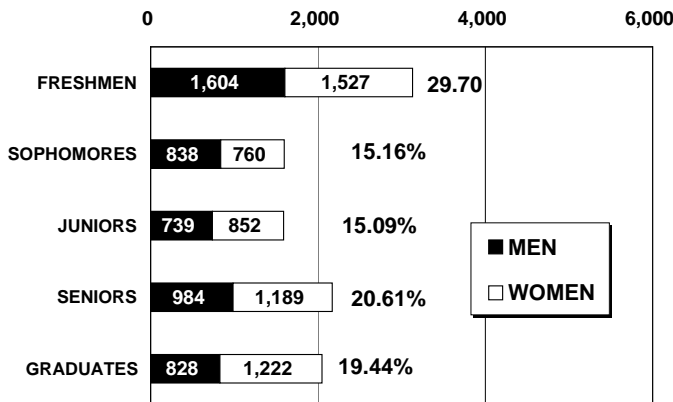

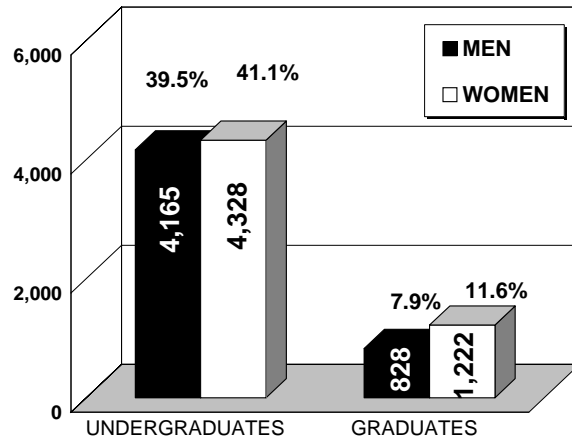

Enrollment by Gender and Classification



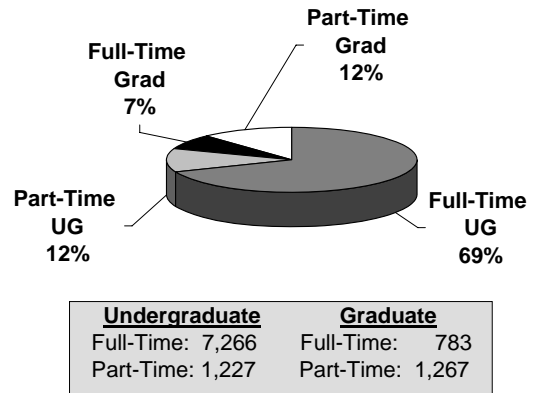
Enrollment by Gender and Level



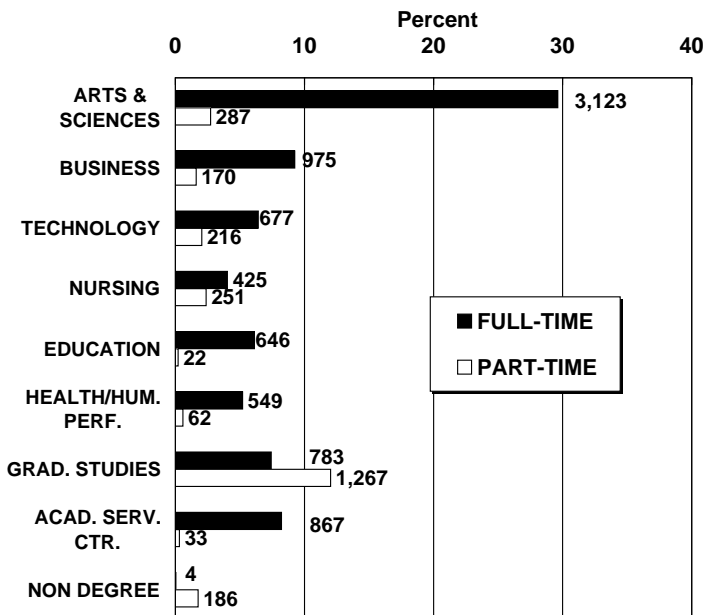

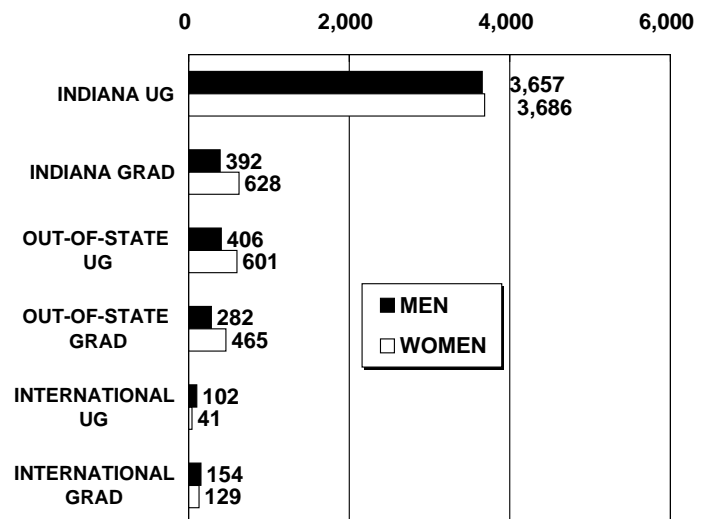
Enrollment by Status and Level



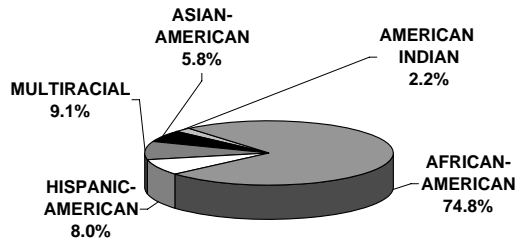
Enrollment by Status and College



Enrollment by Gender, Level, and Residency



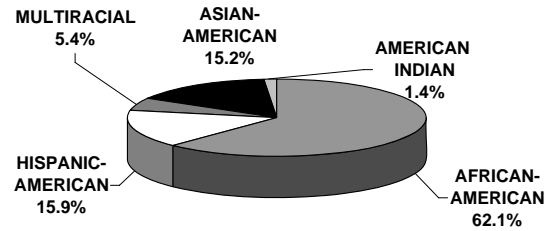
Undergraduate U.S. Minority Students

 Students of unknown origin comprise 189 (2.2%) of all undergraduate students

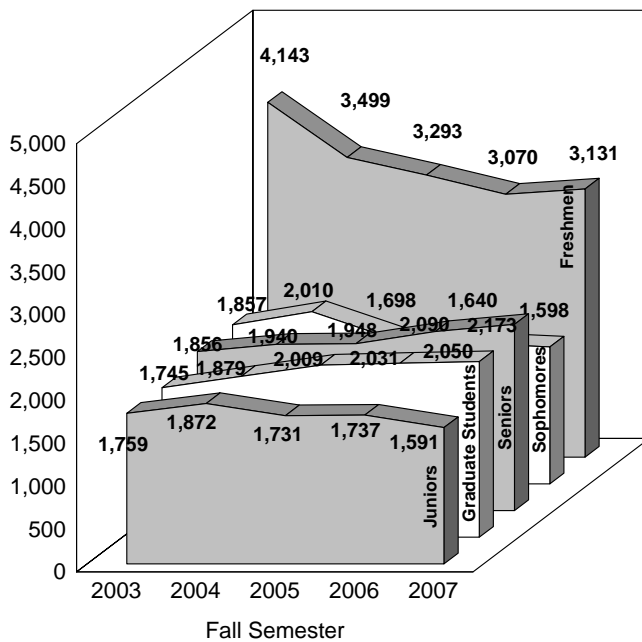

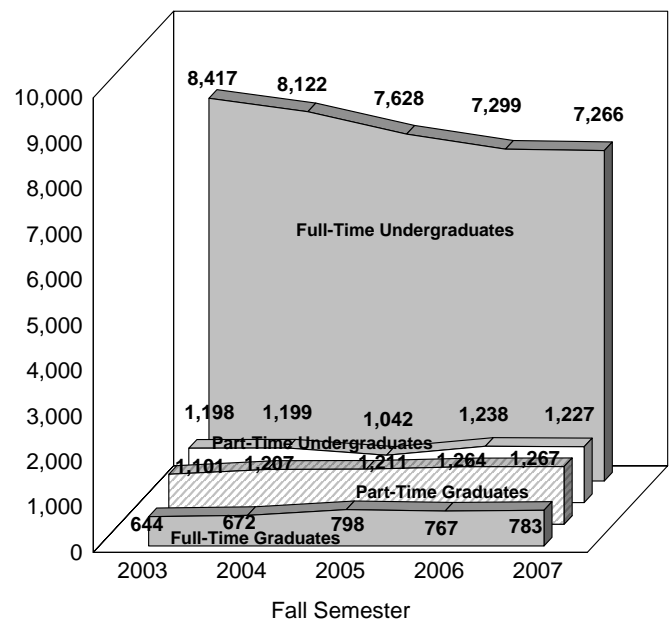
U.S. Minority Students comprise 277 (13.5%) of all graduate students
