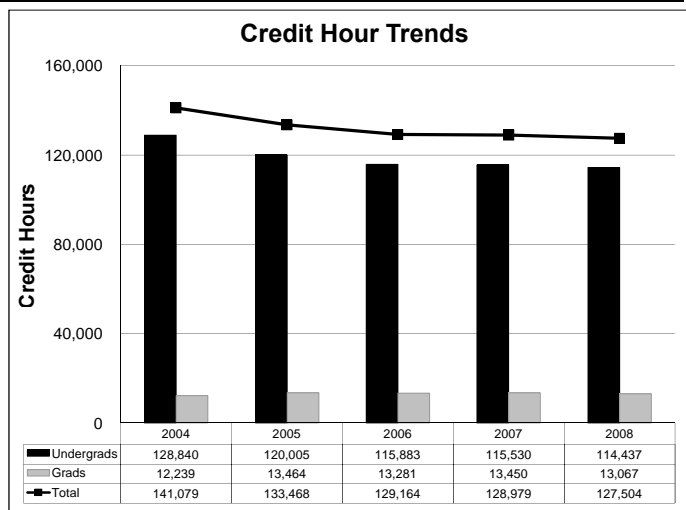
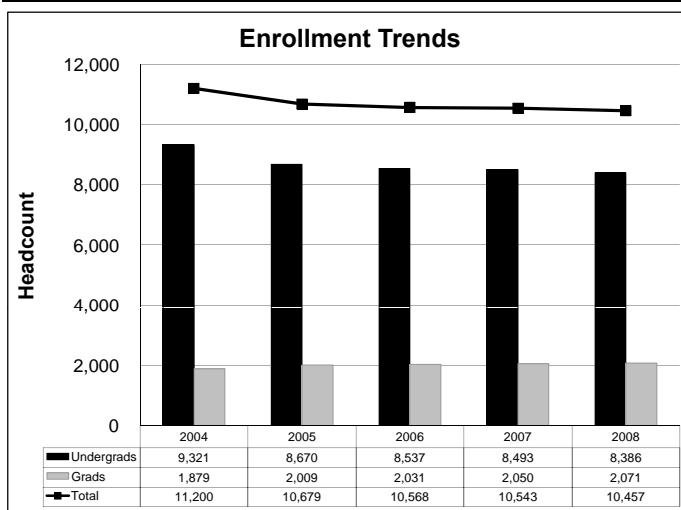

HIGHLIGHTS

ENROLLMENT CHANGES FROM FALL 2007 TO FALL 2008

► **UNIVERSITY TOTALS**

- Total enrollment decreased by 86 students or 0.8%
- Total undergraduate enrollment decreased by 107 students or 1.3%
- Total graduate student enrollment increased by 21 students or 1.0%
- Total full-time equivalent (FTE)³ students decreased by 104.8 or 1.2%.

► **CLASSIFICATION⁴**

- Freshman enrollment increased by 48 students or 1.5%
- Sophomore enrollment decreased by 8 students or 0.5%
- Junior enrollment decreased by 61 students or 3.8%
- Senior enrollment decreased by 86 students or 4.0%

► **COLLEGE**

- Enrollment increased in Student Academic Services (148 students or 16.4%), Graduate Studies (21 students or 1.0%), and in Nursing, Health and Human Services (20 students or 1.6%). Enrollment decreased in Arts and Sciences (192 students or 5.6%), Business (39 students or 3.4%), Education (28 students or 4.2%), Technology (12 students or 1.3%), and in Non Degree (4 students or 2.1%).

► **U.S. MINORITY STUDENTS**

- Total U.S. minority student enrollment increased by 70 students or 4.1%
- Undergraduate U.S. minority enrollment increased by 56 students or 3.9%
- Graduate U.S. minority enrollment increased by 14 students or 5.1%

► **FULL-TIME STATUS⁵**

- Full-time enrollment decreased by 113 students or 1.4%
- Full-time undergraduates decreased by 72 students or 1.0%
- Full-time graduate students decreased by 41 students or 5.2%

► **PART-TIME STATUS⁵**

- Part-time enrollment increased by 27 students or 1.1%
- Part-time undergraduates decreased by 35 students or 2.9%
- Part-time graduate students increased by 62 students or 4.9%

► **IN-STATE RESIDENTS**

- In-state students decreased by 125 students or 1.5%
- In-state undergraduates decreased by 206 students or 2.8%
- In-state graduate students increased by 81 students or 7.9%

► **OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS**

- Out-of-state students increased by 21 students or 1.2%
- Out-of-state undergraduates increased by 39 students or 3.9%
- Out-of-state graduate students decreased by 18 students or 2.4%

► **INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS**

- International students increased by 18 students or 4.2%
- International undergraduates increased by 60 students or 42.0%
- International graduate students decreased by 42 students or 14.8%

¹ The international count shown on Page 1 (444) is different from the international count shown on Page 3 (199+193=392), because Page 1 is based on country of origin at admission and Page 3 is based on ethnicity.

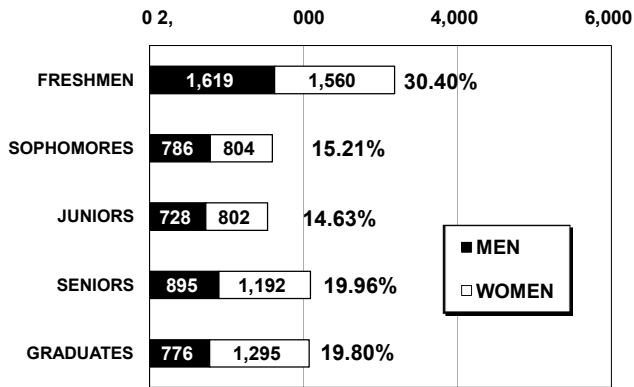

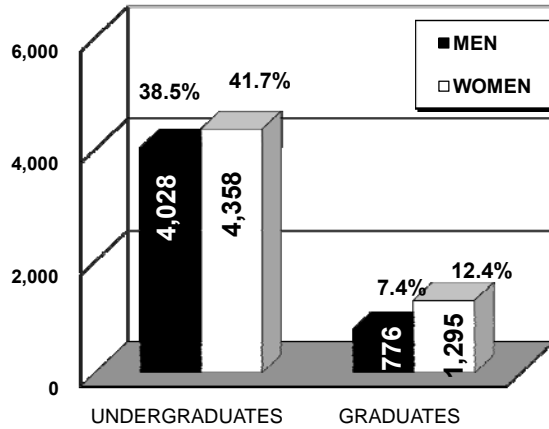

Enrollment by Gender and Classification



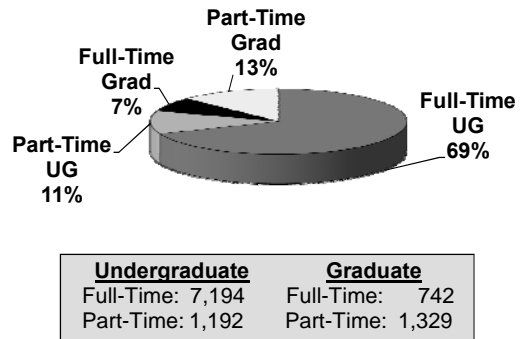
Enrollment by Gender and Level



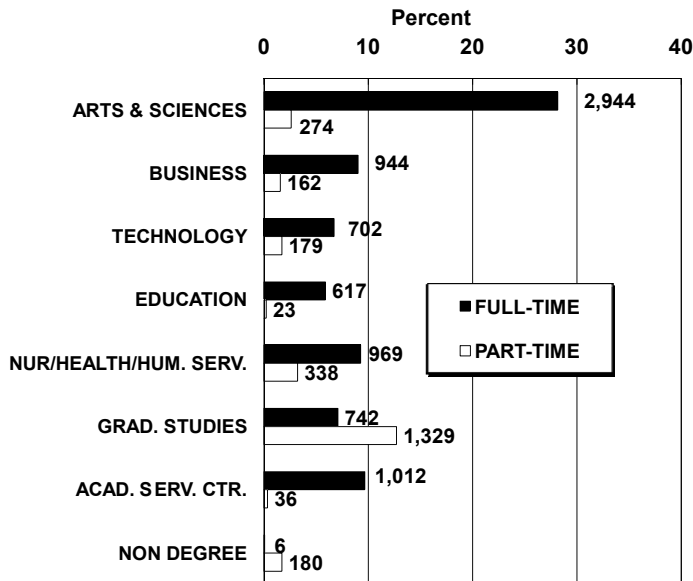

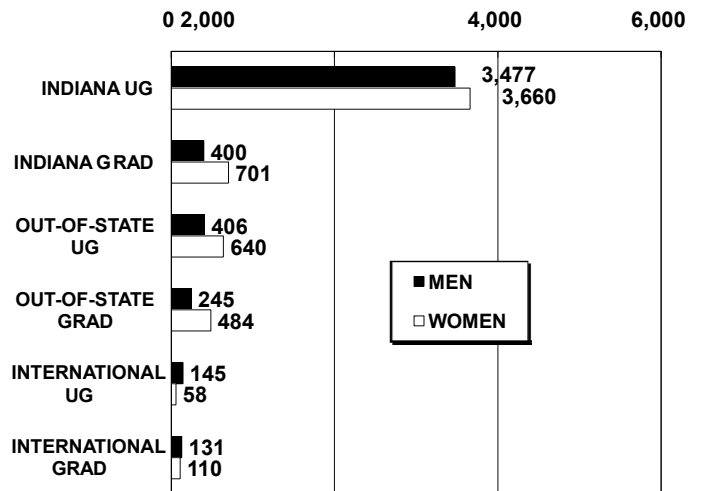
Enrollment by Status and Level



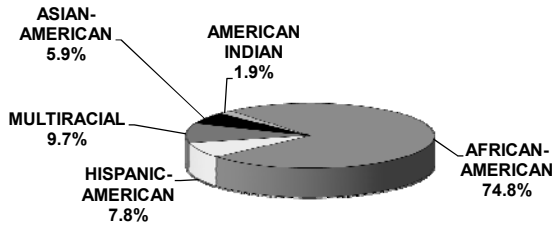
Enrollment by Status and College



Enrollment by Gender, Level, and Residency



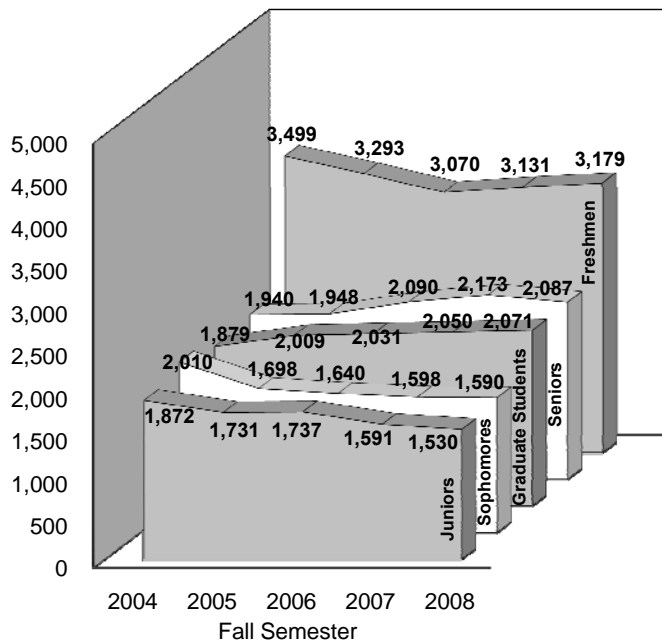

Enrollment Trends by Classification



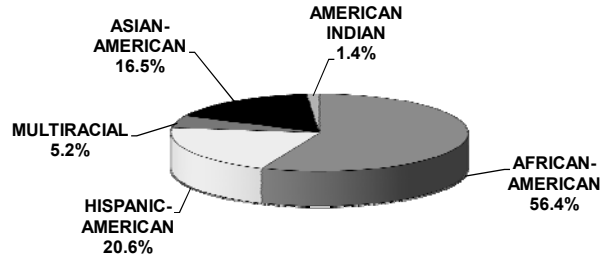

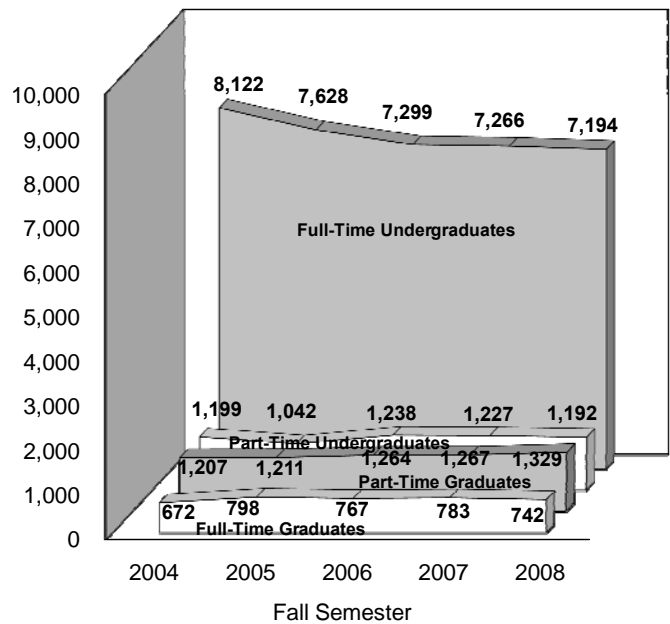
Graduate U.S. Minority Students
