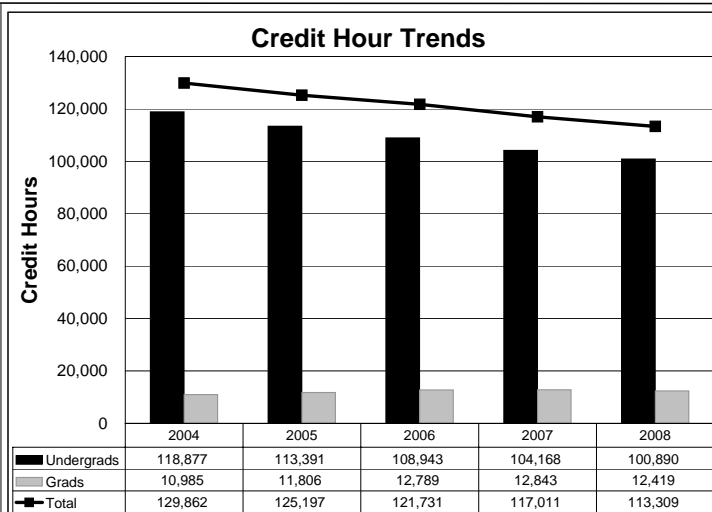
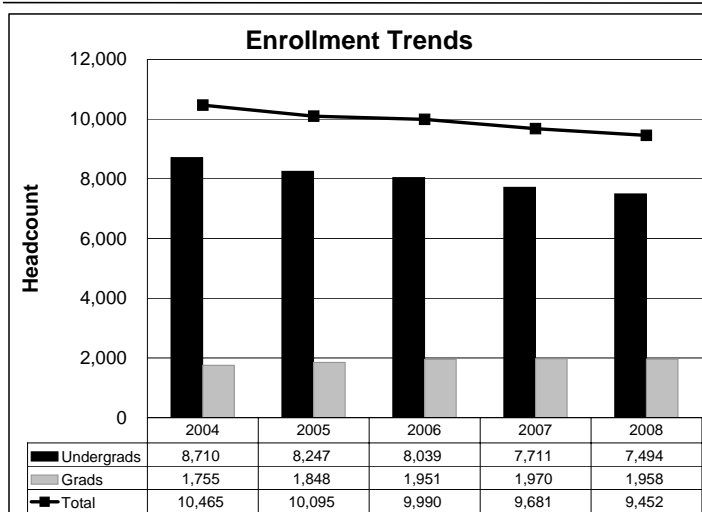

HIGHLIGHTS

ENROLLMENT CHANGES FROM SPRING 2007 TO SPRING 2008

► UNIVERSITY TOTALS

- Total enrollment decreased by 229 students or 2.4%.
- Total undergraduate enrollment decreased by 217 students or 2.8%.
- Total graduate student enrollment decreased by 12 students or 0.6%.
- Total full-time equivalent (FTE)³ students decreased by 253.8 or 3.2%.

► CLASSIFICATION⁴

- Freshman enrollment decreased by 49 students or 2.4%.
- Sophomore enrollment decreased by 11 students or 0.7%.
- Junior enrollment decreased by 149 students or 8.6%.
- Senior enrollment decreased by 8 students or 0.3%.

► COLLEGE⁵

- Enrollment increased in Business (19 students or 1.8%).
- Enrollment decreased in Arts and Sciences (149 students or 4.6%), Technology (48 students or 5.6%), Education (45 students or 7.1%), Student Academic Services (32 students or 4.6%), Graduate Studies (12 students or 0.6%), Non Degree (10 students or 7.9%). This is the first year for the College of Nursing, Health, and Human Services.

► U.S. MINORITY STUDENTS

- Total U.S. minority student enrollment increased by 26 students or 1.8%.
- Undergraduate U.S. minority enrollment increased by 21 students or 1.7%.
- Graduate U.S. minority enrollment increased by 5 students or 1.9%.

► FULL-TIME STATUS⁶

- Full-time enrollment decreased by 279 students or 3.8%.
- Full-time undergraduates decreased by 214 students or 3.3%.
- Full-time graduate students decreased by 65 students or 9.2%.

► PART-TIME STATUS⁶

- Part-time enrollment increased by 50 students or 2.1%.
- Part-time undergraduates decreased by 3 students or 0.3%.
- Part-time graduate students increased by 53 students or 4.2%.

► IN-STATE RESIDENTS

- In-state students decreased by 361 students or 4.6%.
- In-state undergraduates decreased by 354 students or 5.2%.
- In-state graduate students decreased by 7 students or 0.7%.

► OUT-OF-STATE RESIDENTS

- Out-of-state students increased by 120 students or 8.2%.
- Out-of-state undergraduates increased by 104 students or 12.8%.
- Out-of-state graduate students increased by 16 students or 2.4%.

► INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- International students increased by 12 students or 2.8%.
- International undergraduates increased by 33 student or 24.1%.
- International graduate students decreased by 21 students or 7.1%.

¹ International count shown on Page 1 (444) differs from international counts shown on Page 3 (154+248=402), because Page 1 is based on country of origin at admission and Page 3 is based on ethnicity.

² Average Age and Age by Level is based on all students (9,452) for whom age data was available (100% of total enrollment).

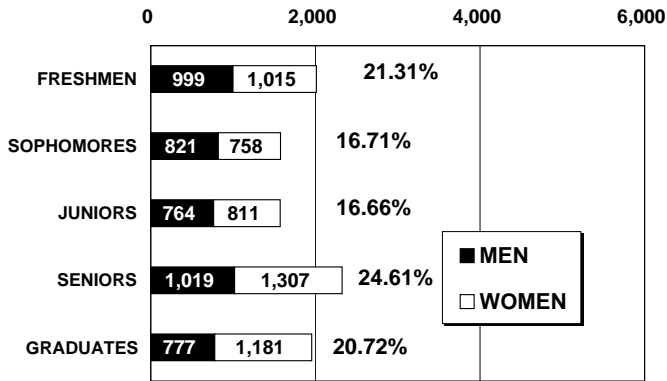

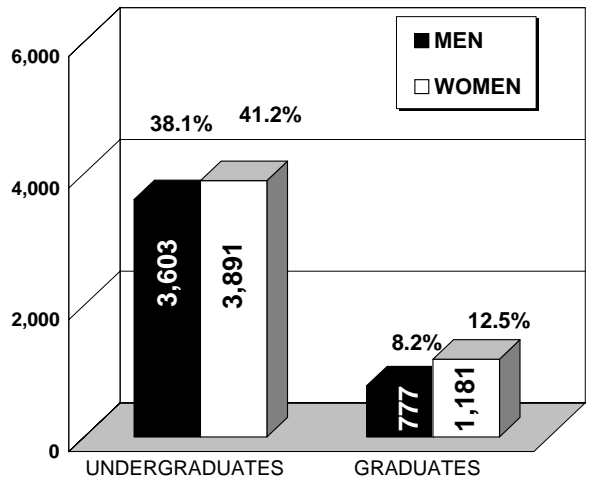

Enrollment by Gender and Classification



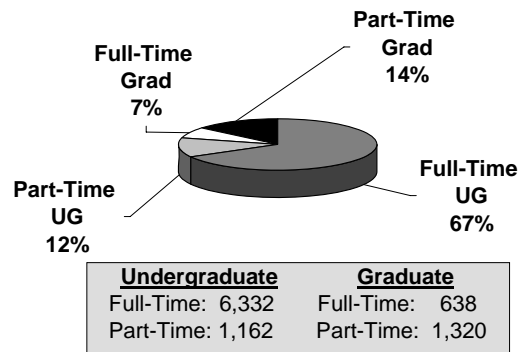
Enrollment by Gender and Level



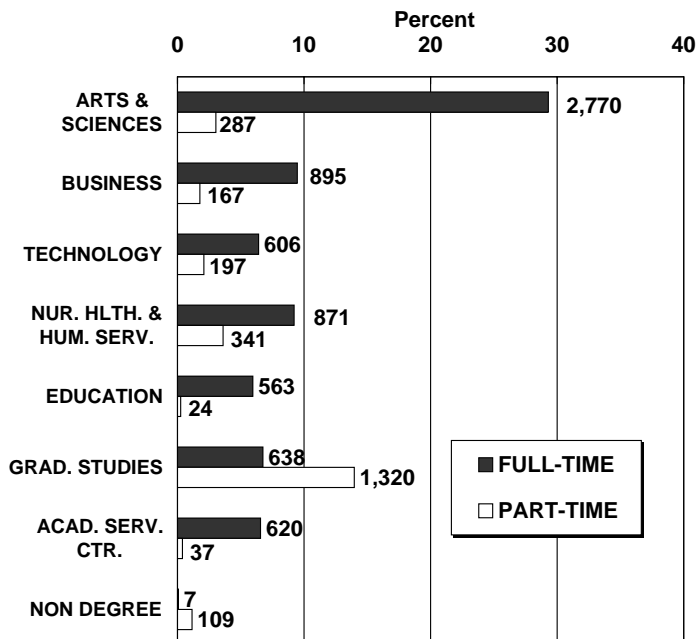

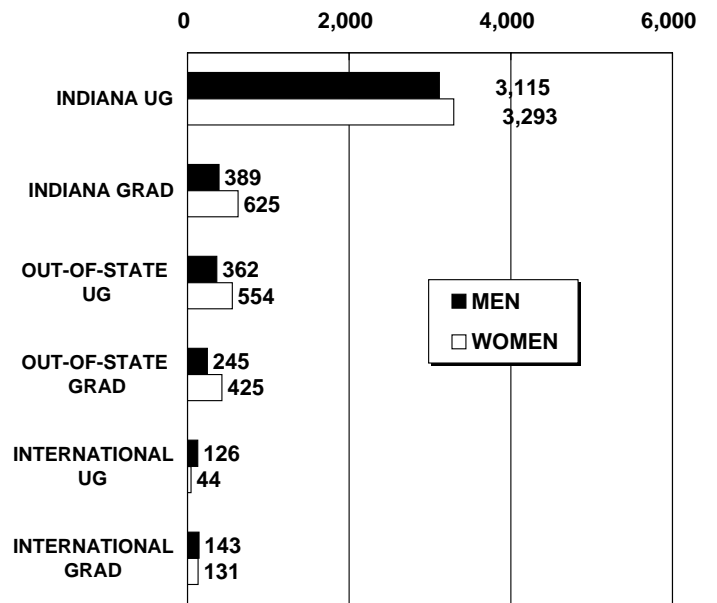
Enrollment by Status and Level



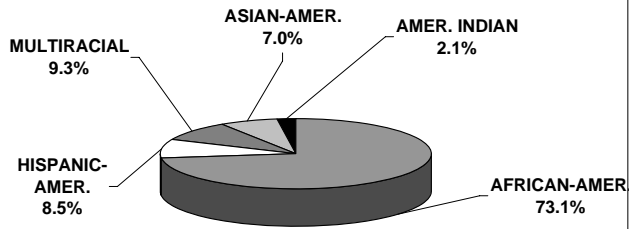
Enrollment by Status and College



Enrollment by Gender, Level, and Residency



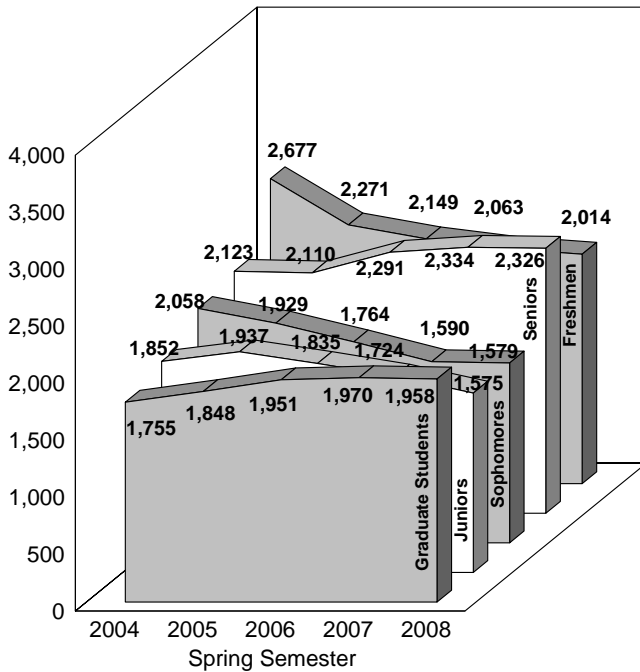

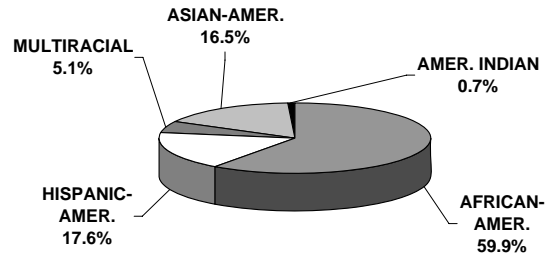

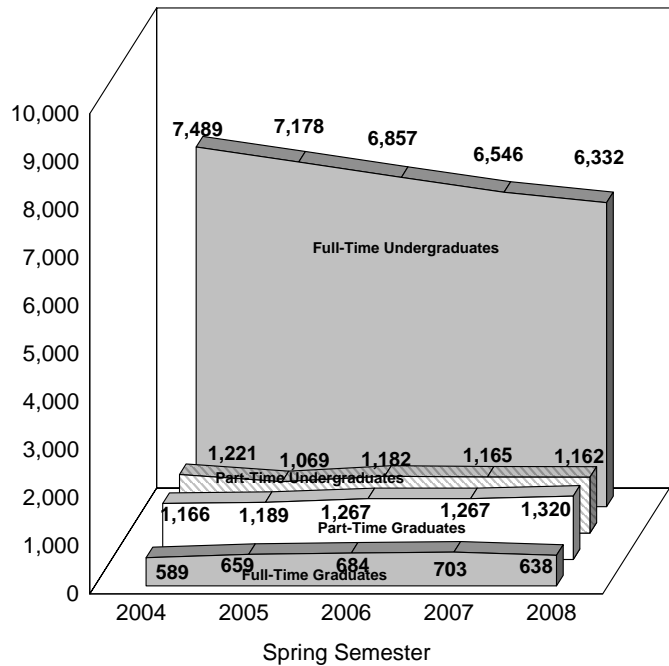
Graduate U.S. Minority Students
