Introduction

As a primarily undergraduate university that is also a doctoral research University (Carnegie classification M4/R), Indiana State University supplements its traditional funding (state and tuition) with research grants and contracts revenue. Our potential for increasing this revenue will be enhanced by support for our faculty in these endeavors. This year's initiative builds upon and learns from the last two years' initiatives.

Purpose

Increase Grants and Contract Revenue

- Increase the number of proposal submissions
- Help build interdisciplinary research teams
- Encourage new faculty to submit grants as practice
- Encourage, reward and recognize grant efforts
- Encourage external grants over internal grant dependency

Methods

COMPETE Awards - Researchers are expected to submit grants proposals totalling 10 times the amount of this seed grant award.

RECOGNITION - letters and medals to faculty successful in winning external grant monies.
