 - a. Development and implementation of online BNC orientation for students (Summer 2017).
 - b. Development and delivery of part-time faculty orientation and training (face to face and online mechanisms of delivery, Spring 2017).
 - c. Departmental policies reviewed and updated including the BNC Student Handbook and creation of new policy for clinical rotations/active duty military (Fall 2017).
 - d. Implementation of Respondus Monitor and lock down browser for all testing within BNC curriculum in conjunction with B Virtual monitoring for higher stakes testing (Fall 2016 and ongoing).
 - e. Implementation of e-simulation within NURS 338 in conjunction with face to face clinical rotations (Fall 2017, ongoing).
 - f. Continued use of learning contracts and one on one chairperson meetings with at risk students with one identified nursing course failure (Ongoing).
 - g. Continued one on one chairperson meeting with any student in violation of academic integrity or student code of conduct (Ongoing).
 - h. Continued use of Quality Matters template and training for online teaching success with Extended Learning for all faculty (Ongoing).
 - i. Continued transition to Kaplan products to ensure utilization of a quality product that is user-friendly and affordable for both faculty and students (final ATI semester summer 2018, complete transition to Kaplan integrated testing, fall 2018).
 - j. Continued remediation efforts and identification of/support for at risk-students (ongoing with student advisor within NURS 338, NURS 324, NURS 424, NURS 444 and NURS 490).
