

Warrant issued for arrest of second suspect in gun incident

Indiana State University police have obtained a warrant for the arrest of a second man in connection with an April 13 incident involving a handgun on a campus parking lot.

The warrant charges Timothy Lewis, 37, of Terre Haute with pointing a firearm, a class D felony, as well as possession of a handgun and battery with injury, both misdemeanors. No shots were fired in the incident. The battery charge is a result of a student being struck in the chin by the body of the weapon. Bail is set at \$25,000.

Lewis' attorney ^{IS MAKING} ~~has made~~ arrangements with police for his client to turn himself in. He is expected to ^{DO} ~~so~~ next week.

Brandon McIntosh of Merrillville remains in the Vigo County Jail following a hearing on Wednesday. He is scheduled for another court appearance April 19 for the filing of formal charges.
